

[REDACTED]; [REDACTED] February 11, 2009: felony conviction of Penal Code section 245(a)(1) (Assault with Force likely to inflict great bodily injury); [REDACTED] February 11, 2009: felony conviction of Penal Code section 459 of 1st degree (residential burglary); (sentenced to six years in state prison).

This represents a very long and VIOLENT criminal record for someone who was only 25 years old at the time of his last offense. Clearly, inmate Weathers is not the type of "non-violent" second strike offender that should merit an early release from prison.

Sacramento County District Attorney's Office strongly believes that he is not an appropriate candidate for early parole, as he poses a considerable threat to society, both in terms of violence against persons and danger to personal property.
