Inmate Johnson is incarcerated as a 'non-violent second striker' because he pulled a gun on his former girlfriend, telling her, "I'm gonna kill you, Bitch." He had previously made numerous threatening statements to her such as "You're gonna die, bitch. If not, you're gonna go to the hospital." When officers were called, Inmate Johnson engaged officers in a foot pursuit until he was eventually taken into custody. A Versa semi-automatic handgun with one live .38 round in the chamber and 5 in the magazine was found. Inmate Johnson was on probation for that offense when he committed his current commitment offense: being a felon in possession of a firearm.

Inmate Johnson has proven that he will use a firearm to commit serious felonies. [REDACTED]
[REDACTED] From his prior behavior, we can only conclude that he presents a risk of violence to public safety. As such, we ask that you deny him early release.
