## DA Anne Marie Schubert Announces the 5<sup>th</sup> Annual Criminal Justice Youth Shadow Day

District Attorney Anne Marie Schubert announced applications are now being accepted for the 5<sup>th</sup> Annual Criminal Justice Youth Shadow Day, a program in partnership with the Sacramento County Sheriff's Department, Sacramento County Probation Department, Public Defender's Office and Sacramento Superior Court.

High school students job shadow professionals from various criminal justice agencies. Based on their interest, students are paired with prosecuting attorneys, defense attorneys, probation officers, law enforcement officers, investigators and judges to get a first-hand look at the criminal justice process and the different roles within the system.

At the end of the day, a career fair is held with various agencies represented.
